INVITATION TO THE TABLE

Leader: Beloved, this is the table of the Risen Lord. He comes to us as He came to Thomas— not to condemn our doubts, but to meet us in them. All who seek

His grace, all who long for His peace, all who desire to believe again—you are invited to come.

People: We come, trusting the One who meets us where we are.

Leader: Let us confess our need for the mercy of Christ.

All: Risen Lord, we confess that fear has closed doors in our hearts. Doubt has dimmed our hope, and sorrow has made us slow to believe. Forgive us. Speak peace to our troubled spirits and breathe Your life into us again. Amen.

WORDS OF PEACE

Leader: Hear the good news: Jesus still steps into locked rooms. He still shows His wounds. He still speaks peace. In Christ, we are forgiven and restored.

People: Thanks be to God.

Leader: On the night of His resurrection, Jesus stepped into a locked room where fear, confusion, and doubt had gathered. And to Thomas — the one who struggled to believe — He offered not judgment, but Himself.

People: Lord, meet us in our doubts as You met Thomas.

Leader: Jesus showed His wounds, the very signs of His suffering becoming the proof of His love. And Thomas declared, “My Lord and my God.”

People: We come to this table with the same confession.

Leader: As we break this bread and lift this cup, we remember the Savior who enters our hidden places, speaks peace to our troubled hearts, and invites us to believe again.

People: Because He lives, we receive His peace.

Leader: This is the body of Christ, broken for you. This is the blood of Christ, shed for you. Take, eat, and believe — for the risen Lord still comes to us, scars, and all, with grace enough for every doubt.
